Module - New Media and Society - 6 Credits

Duration: (10 weeks, 8 hours per week, total 84 hours, including 4 hours of exams). Fees: 300 GEL Author: Marina Vekua, Professor PhD in Journalism

Objectives of the teaching course:

The course aims at students to study the phenomenon of a new media and its role and impact on the modern information society; the relationship between on-line journalism and new media and its main developing trends.

Evaluation system and criteria:

Grading system and criteria: students' grading system and criteria are based on the rule of student's grading system accepted at the University. It includes five types of positive and two types of negative assessments.

The number of credits obtained by the student through the course is confirmed with the positive assessment received for the completion of the work planned in the course syllabus. The grading system of the university is based on knowledge accumulation and systematic assessment principles, according to which it is impermissible to assess: a) only based on final exam; b) only on the total sum of the points received in different components during the semester.

Students semester grading: overall regulation of GTUNI on grading student' academic achievement (order N° 01-01/ 64. "22"July, 2016), which sets unified approaches only to the compulsory components and competence thresholds.

a. Student's semester achievement is assessed with summing up the points gained through single or multiple mid-term assessment plus final exam points.

b. Assessment of the achievements of the academic program components must be complete in the same semester, when it is carried out.
