Item 0: Brief Consultation Rector ONMA Prof. Mykhaylo Miyusov (Michail Miyusov/ONMA)

Item 2: Presentation of CruiseT: Aims, Objectives, Work Packages, aimed Outputs and Outcomes (Dr. Viachaslau Nikitsin/University of Paderborn, Dr. Guido Kaufmann/Kaufmann Unternehmensberatung GmbH)

Guido Kaufmann and Viachaslau Nikitsin explain aims, objectives, work packages, aimed outputs and outcomes of the CruiseT project in detail. Item 3: Project Administration: Preparation of Mobilities, Payments of Saleries, Purchase of Equipment, Bilateral Agreements with University of Paderborn and between Project Partners (Dr. Viachaslau Nikitsin/University of Paderborn, Dr. Guido Kaufmann/Kaufmann Unternehmensberatung GmbH)

This item originally had been scheduled for the following day. Because of sufficient reserve of time it was shifted to this date. Guido Kaufmann and Viachaslau Nikitsin start their presentation with a survey of the management structure of the project and a proposal for the establishment of a project management board. In order to implement the project officially in the partner countries and to regulate payments of financial means bilateral agreements between the University of Paderborn and all project partners will be prepared – as far as necessary. They continue with detailed explanations of all procedures and processes according to the preparation and accomplishment of project mobilities, to payments of salaries and to the purchase of equipment. Item 4: Workshop "Tasks, Service Provision and Institutionalization of Competence Centres" (moderation: Niclas Schaper)

As a discussion basis Niclas Schaper gives a presentation on his ideas regarding tasks, service rovision and institutionalization of the CruiseT Competence Centres. He provides suggestions about aims and objectives, core tasks and core subjects, the organizational structure and financing opportunities of the centres. Harald Pechlaner supports the suggestions of Niclas Schaper by comparing the CruiseT Competence Centres with the European Academy Bozen. He emphasizes that EURAC is acting as a service provider for the regional economy in South Tyrol. From his point of view the most important questions according to a sustainable establishment of centres are the questions of institutionalization and financing.

Alexis Papathanassis quotes some experiences from his research work on cruise tourism. He asks the crucial question whether the project work and the competence centres should be focused closely on the subject cruise tourism or something wider on the touristic attractiveness of the destinations. The majority of the participants votes for the second alternative: to improve the touristic infrastructure and touristic products and provisions at the destinations of cruise tourism. In this case, Alexis Papathanassis emphasizes it will be very important to "tie" tourists to these destinations because their visits are very short. Repeaters usually do not arise from far distances.

Item 6: Conclusion of the Workshop Results (moderation: Niclas Schaper)

This item has been shifted in advance of item 5.

In the discussion about the workshop results it becomes clear that the concept of competence centres still is rather unclear for most of the participants. Thus it is decided to provide some more information about the idea of the CruiseT Competence Centres.
